SPECIAL MEETING OF THE WHEATFIELD TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION *THURSDAY AUGUST 25, 2022, 7:00PM**

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chairman Kapp at 7:01PM.

Roll call: Violet Lentz, Mitch Adelman, Michael Kapp and Denny Kapp, present. James Sherer-absent. Supervisor Wayne Myer was also in attendance.

Approval of agenda: Motion by D. Kapp to approve the agenda, seconded by Adelman. All were in favor-motion carried. Sherer absent.

Approval of minutes of June 16, 2022. Motion by Lentz to approve the minutes of June 16, 2022, as presented, seconded by Adelman. All were in favor-motion carried. Sherer absent.

Public comment: Public comment opened at 7:03PM. Six people spoke. Topics included—tower height, setbacks, the larger area allowing wind turbines in the latest draft, the commissioners are doing what APEX wants and not listening to the wants of the community, thanks for the website, where's the defibrillator, more notes should be included on the website. Zoning Administrator report:

- Myer reported that there was a meeting with township officials and our planner regarding an event barn and a temple. Complete paperwork has not been received as of yet.

Zoning Board of Appeals report: None.

Board of Trustees report:

- D. Kapp reported on two board meetings—the recommended ordinance was passed by the board, there was a request to accept the donation of an old schoolhouse bell, which the board accepted.
- Summer tax collection season is underway and we had an Election on August 2nd.

New Business: The Wheatfield Township website is now live.

Old Business: Wind Energy Systems Amendment. The amendment was received and passed out to commission members and to the public. It is also available on the website. Members have read through but not had sufficient time to study in completely. One member is absent this evening. It will be a discussion item at our next meeting.
